# Governance Updates

The following slides present a summary of governance changes that were approved in 2024 and went into effect Jan. 1, 2025.

### **Governance Updates**

- The term for each Director is three (3) years. **No director may serve more than two (2) consecutive terms.** Individuals may serve again with a service break of at least one (1) year.
- A director is automatically removed upon notice of departure or disqualification of his/her firm from membership, unless the Board of Directors agree, by a majority, to retain the Director for a specified period which does not extend beyond the departure date of the outgoing firm.

### **Member Expectations**

- Members are encouraged to participate in *at least*:
  - Your regional conference
  - World Conference\*
  - Managing Partner Circles
  - Relevant collaboration groups
  - Annual General Meeting
- Members in good standing:
  - Complete the annual return
  - Pay invoices on time
  - Submit any peer reviews or requested documents
