

Important CPA Exam Testing Updates

After being closed in April, some Prometric Testing Centers are scheduled to reopen on a [limited basis](#) on Friday, May 1, 2020. Once testing resumes, there will be several important changes your team needs to know. During each quarter, there is typically a blackout period when candidates are not allowed to take the CPA Exam. NASBA, the AICPA and Prometric recently announced that they are removing the blackout period from June 10-30, and they **will allow** candidates to take the exam during these dates. Additionally, on July 1, 2020, continuous testing will go into effect, which will permanently remove all future blackout periods (with the exception of South Carolina).
