

## Compulsory Labeling of Goods Starts from 2019

We hereby inform you that on April 28, 2018 by Government Executive order of the Russian Federation № 792-p (hereinafter the "executive order"), the following list (hereinafter the "list") of commodity items liable to mandatory labeling by means of identification has been adopted. The executive order comes into effect from January 1, 2019.

This list categorizes commodities which are liable to mandatory labeling by means of identification and fixes an adoption period of statutory labeling in respect of each commodity item.

### **What goods will have to be labeled?**

In particular, from December 1, 2019 the following items, among others, will be subject to mandatory labeling such as clothing, household linen, perfumery products as well as photo cameras, rubber tires and covers.

From March 1, 2019 tobacco products will be subject to mandatory labeling. From July 1, 2019 shoes products will be subject to mandatory labeling.

### **COMMODITY ITEMS TO MANDATORY LABELING BY MEANS OF IDENTIFICATION**

As of today certain labeling methods are not stipulated by the law. The functioning model of the labeling system of commodities is regulated by Government Executive order of the Russian Federation № 791-p. According to this document the creation of a labeling system of commodity items by means of identification in the Russian Federation is assigned to the Ministry of Industry and Trade of the Russian Federation involving State Company "Russian Technologies".
